## **Executive Summary**


The Global Peace Prayer Festival 2025 is a landmark gathering uniting Buddhist leaders, practitioners, and peace advocates from across the world. The main program will feature rare and sacred rituals, including the Jabzhi Gyep, Global Peace Prayer, Bazaguru Recitation, Kalachakra Empowerment, and the Nuns' Initiation Ceremony.

To complement these spiritual highlights, the festival will host a series of side events from 4th to 19th November 2025, designed to enrich its spiritual core while celebrating Bhutan's cultural heritage and community livelihoods. These programs will showcase the country's spiritual, artistic, and community traditions, creating opportunities for artisans, entrepreneurs, and youth while fostering intercultural dialogue and global connections.

Key highlights include the Sacred Relics Exhibition at Punakha Dzong, Global Buddhist Practices, and Peace Dialogues and Dharma Talks led by eminent masters and scholars. Cultural programs at Tendrelthang will bring alive Bhutan's vibrant performing arts, while interactive demonstrations will feature the 13 Traditional Crafts (Zorigchusum), textile weaving, Sowa Rigpa medicine, and astrology.

Participants will also engage in eco-treks, yoga practices, and pilgrimage walks to sacred sites, and explore a pop-up market at Centennial Park showcasing handicrafts, organic products, and enterprises led by women and youth. Together, these side events weave spirituality, culture, and livelihood into a holistic celebration, positioning Bhutan as a global hub for peace, spirituality, and cultural diplomacy.

All activities will culminate in the commemoration of the 70th Birth Anniversary of His Majesty the Fourth Druk Gyalpo Jigme Singye Wangchuck, honoring His Majesty's extraordinary legacy of peace, unity, and Gross National Happiness.






